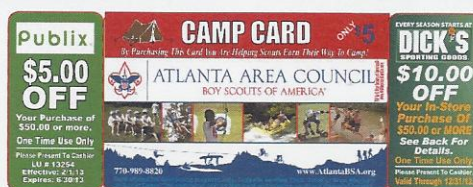

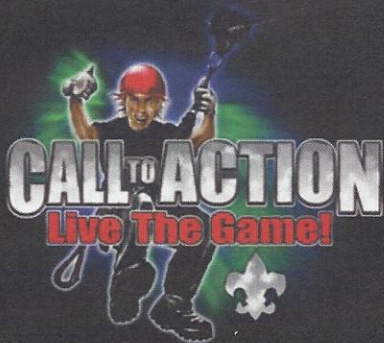

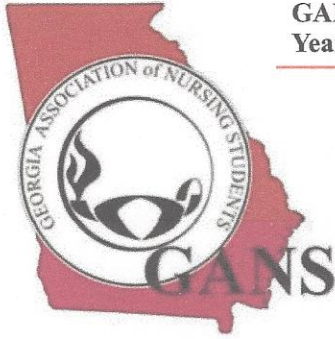


BSA has been hard at work making major improvements to Training and Records. Please provide your Foothills District Training Staff with a listing of adult leaders in your unit and their current trained status. Training records is a function of District Training, not re-charter! Bring your Unit Training Report to Roundtable and deliver to your District Training Chair, Jena Ritchie or email it to FoothillsBadge@gmail.com

To be considered TRAINED both YPT and Position Specific Leader Training are to be completed. In many cases BALOO or ITOLS are required. It is best to attend a local course in our area, but online courses are a backup option.

Re-charters are still being processed. Those who still have not completed YPT or whose YPT is now expired at time of re-charter processing will be receiving a letter of suspension from the Council and will no longer be able to conduct youth meetings until the course is completed. Pro-active completion of this course is encouraged as Scouting moves into a higher level of leadership in the Youth Protection arena.

Foothills will offer Youth Protection Training on April 27th at 8am. Please go to <http://www.foothillsbsa.org/training> to register. We are actively working to identify and develop a YPT Trainer from every Foothills Unit to deliver the new YPT Program to their Leaders and Families directly.
