 - 7. If you want a facility, you can reserve a facility for 2 hour blocks.
 - 8. Then go through the checkout process. At the very end you finally enter the number of participants. The cost is \$0.00. The submission is not a reservation but a request. It becomes a reservation when you get the email receipt and then you contact Veronica. Call her and give her a credit card or mail in a check for \$25 to hold the reservation. She will then email you the reservation.
 - 9. The old system is still in place if you want to use it.
 - 10. Shooting sports may need additional paperwork.
 - 11. Advice. Don't let it time out or you will have to call Veronica to unlock it.
