Registration Renewal: Although our scouting membership lasts through the end of December, NOW is the time we sign up for another fun year. Check your email for the Renewal email (NOTE: the email is sent to the primary address on file for each person- if you don't see your scout's email, ask him to check his email)

Forms (the email) verifying/correcting information + annual Dues are due by October 22nd.

*** Dual registered Leaders and Scouts- if you or your Scout are registered in more than one unit (Troop 714+ cub pack or venture crew) your national dues only get paid 1 time- so if you pay with the other unit, make sure I know! (Scout troop dues are \$80 if paying national registration elsewhere).
