Great opportunities for leadership as well as some of the outings/trips coming up. As soon as the new scouts finish their joining requirements, they can attend any troop activities. Plan is to award the new Scouts their Scout badge (Joining) at the December 9th Christmas party.

2. Re-charter roundup – forms and adult training / roster updates

- a. Good response over the last couple of weeks. 5 or 6 people left. Good shape here. Biggest challenge is around discrepancies of records on a handful of Scouts and Adults, they are being worked out and tracked down. Thanksgiving will be inputting computer work and December will be submitting paperwork. **Training:** Down to 4 YPT folks. We could use help next year for re-charter to make it easier on SM and CC.
- 3. Activity planning support
 - a. Winter Camp (12/27 12/31) 7 Scouts plus Adults signed up.
 - b. Flour Wars (12/14) 12 signed up. \$2 to cover costs is likely. Allatoona Aquatics Base.
 - c. **Merit Badge Clean up (12/15 3-5pm)** progressing. A few signed up. Wendy following up with Ginger Moss to check on counselors. Only attend for things that have already been started and are looking to get some <u>requirements</u> completed. Completing merit badge requirements but not necessarily for completing the entire merit badge.
 - d. **Yorktown** 24 slots and we have 11 filled. Deposit due at beginning of December. Wendy to send email to Ferrell on details. New Scouts will likely show some strong interest there.
 - e. **Merit Badge Clinic (3/1/14).** Annual one sponsored by Troop 714 and open to the district. **Note:** Recent communication has highlighted that troop events such as this can only charge fees for cost recovery NOT as fundraisers.
 - f. **Bethlehem Walk Set up:** Great opportunity for service to the church and counts toward service hours. Food provided for those that work. *Side Note: The order for Citizenship in the Community MB sequence matters. Be careful not to get tripped up and ignore the sequence.*
 - g. **Bethlehem Walk Lock-in**: This is an annual tradition that the troop performs to help deter vandalism of the Bethlehem Walk set while rotating Scouts in 2 hour shifts to be a presence. For New incoming Scouts and visiting Webelos, it is encouraged to stay until midnight if age and energy level is a concern. It is a very long night. Significant parental involvement is appreciated for Webelos (experience has taught us). For those not doing their rounds, the Scouts play games all night.
 - h. Manatees (January 18 20) 32 currently signed up for snorkeling test of the 38 signed up for Swimming with the Manatees with a max cap of 31. Not concerned right now with the overage as some attrition is expected to bring those numbers down. Release forms are mandatory and is posted on the website. Wendy to follow up with June to see how many were collected. All forms and payment due no later than Monday November 25th.
 - i. Scouters Winter Campout (January 10 12). \$15 due now with \$25 due later.
