1. Webelos visiting: Garrison Mill visiting in January. Rocky Mount is not responding. Legacy- Jeff Breaugh and one West child. There have been less than 20 visitors so far. We can take up to 22 Scouts. We will lose 18 years old soon. Need a deadline for the legacy group; last year Dec. 31st.
2. Summer Camp: Sending preview copy of Woodruff Camper Guide. Mountain Man is better and has good words about that. Cost is \$225 this year. First \$60 payment due Feb. 1st. Adults \$75 each after first 2 leaders; \$35 for off site activity. Kickoff is January 11th. High adventure for older kids (age 13 and up). Rock climbing, high ropes and COPE for 14 years and older.
3. Tom Lynch: inventory done. Christine updated spread sheet. Patrol coaches check on action packers and turn back in for inspection. 2 action packers are in the shed. Christine will work with the quartermasters to check all cards and equipment. All people check back in equipment so boys can get stuff returned.
4. High Adventure: Council has opening on possible crew for 2006 (Philmont). We will bid for 2 crews. Lottery on Jan. 17th. If we do not get 2 crews for 2006, we will wait for 2007. The week is late June and get back July 2nd. 12 in a crew with 3-4 adults. The criteria is age, level of activity, how much BP scout has done, and have they been before. Cost \$1200. miles per day varies from 5 – 10 miles per day. Possible O/A group? Troop-sponsored long BP trip first 2 weeks of June.
5. Yorktown: 20 people, 5 adults and 4 vehicles.
6. BP trip: 2 tier; 6 scouts on shorter trip (21miles) Springer to Woody Gap; max climb of 500 ft. Pine Mountain max climb of 250 feet; serious climb on whole trail. Pinhote comparable to Pine Mtn. Great views in winter. Plan A abd B in case of severe cold. Older kids 31 miles (7&8 sections of AT) aggressive trip. Hike end to end. Because of weather, scouts need practice. Hike Dec.23 or Jan 2nd - Kennesaw Mountain minimum of 16 miles, possible 20 miles for MB; need full packs. Younger kids can join. BP checkouts in Spring for March or April.
7. SWC: Jan 6-8. Both patrols have meeting this Sunday. Class ones medical forms to Pamela Roberts ASAP. She will leave early. Visitors do only Class 1. Sites 5A & 5C.
8. MLK holiday: winter BP, back in time for Scout meeting. Wedding Shower that night.
9. Roundtable in Jan.: Carl Lundstom and Rick McNealy.
10. Michael Slother needs letter of recommendation turned in by Friday.
11. Court of Honor: Jan. 23rd. Chad Murray and Kyle Moore are the MCs. FCM will speak to the librarian. Script must be prepared and approved by the SPL and ASPL. Librarian may need to organize stuff.
