

## Adult Leader Meeting

1. Effective Jan 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008: Merit badge and rank requirements have changed.
2. Wood Badge courses available (3) March 31<sup>st</sup> - April 5<sup>th</sup>. Green Bar training for adults. Learn great skills, leadership and team development.
3. NYLT- Green Bar: online application now. Scouts must be 13 or older, First Class, gone to 2 summer camps and serving as officers or the potential to be a troop officer. Great training and fun.
4. New Scout Recruiting: 9 applications from 1417. We need 2 new scout leaders, ASMs with one being the lead ASM. Pack 417- 2 scouts possible.
5. Camporee and O/A Tapout: \$8.00 plus food. Eligible for 2 adults to be tapped out. We need an adult in charge for this event and an adult in charge of the game. Mr. Moultrie is the ASM. We have a scout in charge. We need to act as staff for one District event for Chicken Pin requirement. We can run one of the games. The theme is Survivor. March 28-30.
