1. NESA Day May 18th. Give your \$5 to Mrs. Webster.
2. Flag Placement: May 27th. There will be a sign-up sheet next week. Information is on the website.
3. Hiwassee trip: June 9th-11th: need other adults. Mr. Pfau will be going. Must be at least First Class and have passed the swim test. This is a canoe trip.
4. Summer Camp: Second payment is already due. June 5th is the last payment. Next parent meeting is very important meeting for Summer Camp info. Mrs. Roberts needs all medical forms by that date. We will be collecting meds ahead of time. Prescription must be in a prescription labeled bottle. Scouts that are on ADD meds, please continue them during the summer camp due to they have to be able to focus. Older scouts with adult supervision are teaching these merit badges. It is not fair to the counselor or the scout. If your child has ever had asthma, they must have an inhaler. This also applies to scouts who need epi. pens for allergies.
