

## Patrol Leader's Council Meeting

October 25, 2004

1. There was a good turnout for the Backpacking trip.
2. Scouting For Food: 3x5 cards need to be handed out each week and number of cans recorded for each Scout in your Patrol so they can be transferred to the poster for a weekly update. If you donate food to a church, etc. this counts in your count for 50 cans and or non-perishable items. Lets have 100% participation.
3. John Watkins is whom you call if your Patrol needs Service Projects.
4. Quarter Master Report: Backpacking supplies that were checked out have not all been turned back in. Patrol Leaders need to let Scouts know to bring back gear to the next meeting. For all Patrols except the New Patrols, the action packers need to be turned back in to the Quartermasters to be inspected at the next meeting. New Scouts will keep their action packers until May when they have their elections.
5. OA Report: Kyle Hughes and Sean Steifgerwald are going to the Make-Up Ordeal November 5<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>.
6. Librarian Report: We are waiting to find out the money situation before we can purchase new Merit Badge Books. He plans on getting the MB books checked back in for the Scouts who are finished with them so he will be ready to pass it on to the new Librarian.
7. Troop Guides Report: Pack 1417 is going to visit our Troop soon.
8. Anacondas Report: November 6<sup>th</sup>: They will work on Scouting For Food, have a Patrol meeting and plan an outing for the November 15<sup>th</sup> meeting.
9. Penguins Report: They are going to repair the doors of the shed this weekend and work on Scouting For Food.
10. Dragons Report: Scouting For Food, Cycling trip and a Patrol Meeting planned.
11. Cobras Report: Scouting For Food: they will let Mr. Moultrie know by Monday the plans for the Patrol.
12. Dragons Report: Scouting For Food, possible outing on November 2<sup>nd</sup> and a meeting with Mrs. Franz to plan Holiday Party.
13. Roadrunners Report: Six Scouts are going on Cycling trip: Scouting For Food.
14. Lightning Report: Patrol flag was finished. Cycling trip. Make plans for Scouting For Food.
15. Flaming Falcons Report: Den Chief Training, Merit Badge University, backpacking and cycling trip and plans for Scouting For Food. 8-12 Scouts out of Patrol are very active.
16. Philmont Trip planned for 2006: Register by November 20<sup>th</sup> if interested. Need a deposit by the end of the year. 12 day trip and must be in 7<sup>th</sup> grade or above. Kenny Murray in charge.
17. John McFarland is in charge of the Scout National Jamboree July 25<sup>th</sup>. We will camp in the West Park of Virginia, 2 hours away from the Jamboree. Minimum of 3 days camping, 5 day trip. Day hikes and canoeing. Cost will be camping, food, gas, and activities. Mr. McNealy will be helping with trip. Need Adult support.
18. If Patrol has 100% participation and meets the commitment of 50 cans per Scout, they may pass on outstanding Service Projects.

19. Johnny King (Flaming Falcons) made a suggestion of the Troop setting up or running a booth for Bethlehem Walk. John Watkins said that was a great idea and could man the rope-making booth since they know their knots. Johnny will bring a flyer to Monday's Meeting to see if there is any interest with the other Scouts. An adult must be present at all times. 2-3 boys at a time to work booth. Church adults will cover Monday night due to Holidays party.
20. Bethlehem Walk set up is November 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> and take down is December 11<sup>th</sup>. Great Service projects.
21. Seabase trip has 2 openings left. Sign up on Monday night if interested.
22. Patrol Leaders need to make sure the Troop outing occurs on November 15<sup>th</sup> within their Patrols. A visit to the Fire Station is planned for those who want to finish their Fire and Safety MB.
23. We need Master of Ceremonies for the January Court of Honor.
24. Older Scouts remember to set the example for the younger Scouts. **THEY ARE WATCHING YOU!**
25. The minimum requirement for Patrols is at least 6 active Scouts. Otherwise the Patrols may have to merge together.
26. The Fire Station Trip: November 15<sup>th</sup>. Meet at station at 6:50pm. Class A uniforms. Turn in fire packets completed.
