- 1) Scoutmaster comment: Delighted to see all patrols represented.
- 2) Librarian: Return all library books that are out. Troop Guides: Working with the New Scouts to finish their requirements. Trees: program for August, turned in planning sheets. Penguins: 2 Patrol meetings, 2 went to summer camp, 1 to Northern Tier, Program in September Aviation, sent E-mail for service project in October, 1 did MUST lunches. Duct Tape: summer camp, Northern Tier, and MUST lunch. Cobras: MUST lunches, service project. Timberwolves: summer camp, and Mountasia. Thrashers: almost all attended summer camp, and half patrol went to Northern Tier.
