This was a meeting to discuss reimbursement for Scout trips.

- 1. When a driver volunteers to pull the trailer, he will be reimbursed for gas.
  - 2. Do we reimburse drivers for short trips as well as long trips?
  - 3. For long trips we need to get a deposit to hold their place. If Scout cancels within a certain time period, he may lose his deposit.
  - 4. For long trips over 150 miles one-way, there will be a fixed formula, which applies to everyone. The deposit will figure in the money for gas.
  - 5. **Formula** is: gas cost / vehicle= # miles X 2 (round trip) divided by 22 miles/gallon X \$2.00/ gallon. **Participant contribution** for gas: Gas cost/ vehicle X # of vehicles/ # of participants.
  - 6. Short trips fewer than 150 miles will not be reimbursed and can be deducted on your taxes at your discretion.
  - 7. The Committee voted on the policy, and it was agreed on unanimously.
  - 8. The new policy will be presented to the Troop and will be available on the Troop's website and in the next Newsletter.
