Here are my (delayed) notes from the August 1 roundtable.

New format introduced for the new season. Boy, Cub, and Venture Scouts are combined at the start for the pre-meeting mixer and announcements, and then split off into different areas for their own meetings. Responsibility for opening ceremony and food rotates between Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts.

T714 won the spirit stick. We need to add a totem. I'll hand it over at the next leader meeting. Normally this would mean that 714 is responsible for flag ceremony and food next month, but the Cub Scouts are handling that for Sept.

Wayne Marcinko (the singing SM) is running the Roundtable for the new season, taking over from Mike Cherches.

The meeting had a cooking demonstration for the Boy Scouts portion. Three troops set up in the parking lot. We had french toast w/ bacon, chicken and ride, and shepherd's pie, with dutch oven cake for dessert. :) Marcinko is already looking for volunteers to do this again next year.

Merit Badge Counselors: Applications for NEW counselors must be signed by David Jaracz (District Advancement Chairman) BEFORE turning in the apps to the program center. Bring them to roundtable, or make arrangements. He will not take them and turn them in, though. Doesn't want the responsibility.

Also: All references on MB Counselors Apps MUST BE CALLED and checked prior to turning in the application. (Not clear to me how they're going to enforce this.)

Jaracz also mentioned there was some discussion at the last district meeting about troops hosting MB Clinics and that troops should NOT treat these as a fundraiser. I gather this is somewhat controversial.

There will be a Week 4 NYLT session over the winter break, Dec. 26-31. It will overlap with Winter Camp.
