Aquatics Merit Badge: Daniel Boone: Water is COLD! For a smaller or weaker kid, probably not a good place to start for badge. 12 sign-ups-Raptors and New Scouts.

Swimming Merit Badge: Full Chris Davis' name whited out. Kids on swim team or who have had swim lessons do better with this badge.

Mr. Moultrie suggested that Mr. Betts talk to Dennis Rowe (cell phone call) about getting more through the program at Lake Allatoona. Perhaps we could sweeten the deal by offering some qualified leadership.

First Aid: There should be 21, but currently, all we have are 5. We need all new scouts to complete this. The cutoff date is about 2 weeks out. We are not opening this merit badge to other troops. June 7.

Mr. Moultrie mentioned that the "Mystery Scout" that was coming from Mr. Morin's troop is actually at 713 instead. The question was asked about a rumor about 2 scouts joining us from another troop, but no one had information.

Mr. Moultrie: Had a request about the adults in the room talking while program is being presented. There have been complaints from scouts. Mr. Moultrie asked for everyone's help to improve this.

Uniform: There is a uniform problem. More scouts are wearing only partial uniforms. If the whole uniform cannot be worn, none of it should be. Uniform inspection is in May. Close-toed shoes are very important and a safety issue. We are setting the example. By May, everyone should have the uniform. Arrangements can be made for those who truly can't afford it.
