

Adult Leader Meeting

February 22, 2005

1. Scout Sunday: 2/27; Carl Lundstrom to do Calling Post to everyone. There will be an insert of the Troop's history in the Church bulletin.
2. Kayak Trip: 3/10-3/13; 17 Scouts and 6 adults. There will be basic training on the river for the younger Scouts. ASMs are Mark and Robin Neas for the younger Scouts. Ferrell for the older Scouts. For the younger Scouts, they may have their gear delivered to their campsite. Mark Neas will talk to John regarding younger Scouts.
3. SSD/SA: 2/26-Safe Swim Class at the VSC.
4. Recertification: 2/24, Thursday At Roswell Street Baptist Church for Adults.
5. Matt Frazier and Ben Trimmer are going to help with games at the Camporee in April. James Poole agreed to be the ASM for the Camporee, Todd Trimmer is the Adult in Charge, and Kyle Hughes is the Scout in Charge. OA Tap Out; 11 Scouts and 2 adults will be tapped out.
6. Junior Leader Training: 3/26. A sign-up sheet was put out last night. 4 out of 8 Scouts from the JLT that was canceled have signed up.

They will accept swim checks from own Troop if signed by a lifeguard. March 21st is next payment. Pamela will register the Troop on March 1st. She must have camp schedule by 2/25 from each Scout.
