

## Adult Leader Meeting

April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2005

1. Cumberland trip: 2 Scouts have not paid deposit. One ASM and his son may not be able to go. We have 1 driver, 7 Scouts and no ASM at present. Mr. Decker is a maybe. Mr. Breitzkreuz is the adult signed up to go. We need to see if we an ASM or other adult willing to go. BSA requires a trained leader, but our Troop requires a trained ASM. Deposit is due on 5/2/- \$40.00.
2. New Scout Campout is done and was a success. No injuries, and almost everyone had a good time. Some Scouts cannot wait until the next trip. A comment from one parent, he did not like camping until this weekend and now he has changed his mind. The idea of separating boys from their parents has received positive feedback.
3. First Aid Campout: June 24-26<sup>th</sup>. Very important for new Scouts. Mr. Moultrie will be teaching Safe Swim Defense/ Safety Afloat (SSD/SA) to interested adults. It is important to get adults trained due to there being a lot of water activities in Scouts. The more adults trained, the better program we can offer to the boys. There will also be swim checks for summer camp and Aquatic Merit badges offered. Sign up sheets will be at the May 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting.
4. Mr. Como is taking SSD/SA on April 30<sup>th</sup> to be able to pass boys off for the swim checks. Adults also need to pass a swim test if going to Summer Camp. There must be 1 trained adult per 20 boys.
5. April 30<sup>th</sup>: This is also Summer Camp Physicals. Arrive early, around 8am to ensure to get seen. Cost is \$2. Any Scouts older than the Penguin Patrol will probably need one as well as the adults. Adults over 40 need a Class 3 and can be done here. Flower baskets will also arrive and Scouts need to pick up their orders. Questions? Gail Luttrell.
6. Summer Camp: Next payment due at May 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting. \$65.00
7. Spring Camporee and O/A event. We need one Scout from this group to help with a service project on Saturday. We will meet at the Church at 6pm. Eat before you come. If your scout is a candidate, then parents

- may want to be there. 2 O/A representatives and the Chaplain will be there.
8. May 1<sup>st</sup>: Eagle Court of Honor: Mark Braswell, Jeremy and Jason Earnest. 4pm at MVUMC. There will be food after the ceremony. Please plan to attend.
  9. May 2<sup>nd</sup>: Troop and Parent's Meeting. Troop Elections. We will elect a Senior Patrol Leader, and he appoints an Assistant Patrol Leader. We have 2 tickets: Michael McFarland and Eric Neas; and Matt Lynch and Matt Slothers. Troop Positions will be open. SPL and ASPL decide who gets the positions. Scouts should write down every position they are interested in doing.
  10. May 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>: Patrol Campouts. This is a requirement for Patrol Leaders to get their leadership credit by making sure they have this campout planned and sees it happen. An alternate date can be used, but the final plan should be ready to present by PLC on April 24<sup>th</sup>.
  11. May 9<sup>th</sup>: Patrol elections. This does not involve the New Scouts. Patrols elect a new Patrol Leader. Scouts can transfer to another Patrol, but there are rules. No Scout can be orphaned and left behind. Patrol must have at least 6 Scouts and no more than 12-14. Patrol must have a Patrol Leader and an ASM. No Patrols split until approved by PLC. Patrol Leader cannot be elected if he is not present unless he has agreed to run for the Patrol Leader.
  12. Troop is getting plastic shelves for the shed. Parent help is needed to help with the Troop's equipment. For more information contact Tom Lynch. Several items are in need of repair. A request for 1-2 action packers and new bottles for bleach was made. There is a new card system for checking out and in equipment.
  13. May 13-15<sup>th</sup> or 20-22<sup>nd</sup>: O/A Ordeal. If a Scout is tapped out, he must attend one of these weekends.
  14. May 16<sup>th</sup>: Court Of Honor. Scouts will receive their ranks and Merit Badges.
  15. May 17<sup>th</sup>: Next Adult Leader Meeting.
  16. May 22<sup>nd</sup>: Den Chief Training. Last one until the fall.
  17. May 29<sup>th</sup>: GreenBar: 3 Scouts have requested to go.
