

## Adult Leader Meeting

1. Scout needs service signed off before scoutmaster conference. Please turn in hours @ [Service@troop714.org](mailto:Service@troop714.org). Patrol service counts for advancement, but doesn't count for 2 different rank requirements.
2. Mr. Moultrie heard from 2 adults for the ski trip. One adult may go. Mary estimates \$200-\$250 per person depending on the number going. It could be lower if more people go. 2-3 families here at meeting are interested. Estimate 25 people. Need to make reservations soon. Possible Christmas fundraiser selling wreaths. (Kyle and Tim Morris) Cataloochee, and Sugar Mountain suggested. Mr. Moultrie will send out another email and calling post regarding this trip and a meeting with interested parents and Mary Pfau to make plans.
3. Family Campout: Reservations made at Red Top Mountain. Need money from families. 21 sites with shower house. 2 tents per site. Go to log cabin to check in and get parking pass. You can check in as early as 2 pm. Vickie Mattle will go early. Timberwolves would like to camp together. Night Hawks will be "Host Group" for information. Self service pass for the day.
