

Adult Leader Meeting

January 9, 2010

1. Friends of Scouting Campaign has started. Please help support the Scouts.
2. Recruiting: Mr. Bilkert- has some applications in hand. 9 scouts from Davis, 2 scouts from Rocky Mount, 2 scouts from Mountain View, maybe 4, and 1 scout from Keheley. Garrison Mill-? Possible 16 scouts. The Webelos loved the mystery cook-off. Jeff will draft up something to send to Ferrell regarding needing ASMs for these scouts crossing over, dues and fees and summer camp. There are 15 Webelos I's at Davis that could be crossing over next year. Davis and Rocky Mount have asked for help with their crossover. We need to get the red boxes for the spring for the new scouts. New Scout Campout is in April. Mr. Rowe is the adult cook leader. Mr. England and Mr. Moultrie will be on the adult side with the parents. Mr. Sands will be pulling the trailer.
3. Scouting for Food: Feb. 15th. We will turn in the food in March to Must Ministries to get credit. Each scout should get 100 cans. We are getting 3000 bags from Publix (Barbara). We need to make up fliers. We want to make this more teamwork within the patrol. Patrol leader will be responsible for checking in the food and keeping the tally for each of his patrol members each week. He will turn this number into Debbie Fowler each week. We made a huge impact on Must last year. This is a Council wide program. Final turn in of cans is March 22nd. We need to get an announcement in the church bulletin. Thanks to Colleen who is the adult in charge.
4. Summer camp: 32 scouts show interest; 21 going into the merit badge program, 7 in the adventure to Eagle program, and 4 in the high adventure program. We have 6 adults all week, 1 adult the first half of the week and 2 adults the second half of the week. There will probably be about 14 Webelos going, so we need adults for these scouts. Susan and Karen will be handling the meds. We have one person committed to pull the trailer, but need one more person to pull the other trailer. We may need drivers.
5. O/A elections: Feb. 1st. Mr. Moultrie will get the list of eligible scouts to the ASMs. The scouts have to be first class, have 15 nights of camping with at least one week at summer camp. There will be a 15 minute presentation on O/A and 5 minutes on summer camp.
