

Parent Meeting

January 8, 2006

1. SWC: Pamela Speedbump Roberts. Medical forms saved her because she couldn't find her insurance cards. Medical information on medical forms must stay current at all times, very important. If anything changes, let Pamela know as soon as possible.
2. Summer Camp: Woodruff; July 9th-15th. Good presentation on the camp and the activities. January 23rd is the deadline for sign-up for summer camp with deposit of \$60 due. Third year Scouts should take Environmental Science, highly recommended. 4/24th- \$70 due and 6/19- balance due plus any extra fees. Pamela will find out about who will be giving out medications this year. There will be a deadline for medical forms this year, and medications may have to be turned in early. Adults planning to go: \$75 total. \$60 deposit due 1/23 and rest by April payment. If an adult is splitting the week, they will split the fees. Pamela will find out what is in the Scout accounts before the second payment is due. She is going to a meeting on Wednesday to find out more about summer camp. April 1st is the date for merit badge sign-up. White water rafting or horseback riding is built into the Scout fee. If adults want to participate in these activities, it is a \$ 35 fee.
