3. Scribe: We need a new roster with the Blackhawks positions. Michael Razzano is Patrol leader and Logan Barney is Scribe. Quartermasters: Patrol Leaders need to pick up their action packers from the shed tonight. Chaplain's aide: Scout Sabbath and Scout Sunday: attendance rosters were turned in. Troop guides: Pack 1417 from Davis, 7 scouts are crossing over on March 17th. Spencer is crossing over. New Scout Camp-out. Librarian: No report. Historian: He has the scrapbooks now.
4. Thrashers: program patrol last month. It went well. Patrol camp-out is Allatoona. Gladiators: turned in their program outline. Not sure about patrol camp-out yet. 8. Thrashers have service next month. Arrive 15 min. early and stay until SPL and scoutmaster dismiss patrol.
9. Someone spoke with Mrs. Thorne about picking up trash and raking for their patrol. Blackhawks signed up to clean up around dumpsters and shed. Gladiators and Nitehawx look at website for list of service projects, first 3 and last one are taken by other patrols.
10. Merit Badge Clean-up was canceled due to no support. Two out of two MB clean-up days not held.
11. We need 2 Master of Ceremonies for a campfire for Providence Canyon and for the New Scout Camp-out. This is a requirement for the Communications MB.
12. Scouting for Food: Collect cans as a patrol can be more effective. This also can count for service hours. We already have a Scouting for Food display to record the number of cans per scout brought in. Are Buffaloes are going to win again this year. Pizza and ice cream are incentives. Goal is 4000 cans over the next month. Goal is 85% of scouts to collect 50 cans.

21. Jamboree: held every 4 years for scouts all over the U.S. Summit- 4th high adventure base. Huge amount of land donated and will be the permanent home for the Jamboree. Council is sending around 200 scouts. Flyer is on the website.
