7:05 Meeting begins. Mr. Moultrie thanks Ms. Yuen and Ms. Rogers for attending Round Table. Blackhawk patrol will have the responsibility this month. (Whoever has service patrol duties also is responsible for sending at least two adults to RoundTable.

Contrary to previous years, the youth planning meeting will occur in August before the adult planning meeting. This will enable us to support the program that they have chosen.

Camporall: 30 of our scouts have signed up, which makes a total of 68 youth. 12 Webelo adults are coming, with a total of 38 adults. Dave Davenport is both going and driving. There was some discussion about cars and transportation needs and we need to check to see if both trailers will go with us. The campsite needs to be big enough for 69 people, which is a challenge. We need to make sure that Sherry has a total number of scouts in order to accommodate our needs. Scott Anderson said that he should have a program to review soon. There will be an activity during dinner prep time. A reminder to bring work gloves for the utensil-less cooking for the patrol cooking competition. Departure time for Camporall will be 5:30PM. Please eat before. There will be a backpacking prep competition at Camporall. There will be 5 cook groups. 15 Webelos will be involved. Dinner—Webelos participate in utensil-less cooking. After the Campfire, there will be a mystery trail scavenger hunt with a Halloween theme. This is optional. Patrols need to come up with skits. An adult need to be working with the committee of boys to birddog them.

Blackhawks and Phoenix: **Date for Den Chief training?** Patrick Findley is hurt. Pamela came to the troop meeting but left quickly. We think we have 2 Blackhawks and 6 Phoenix interested in training. Joe Como stated that he would coordinate with Pamela Roberts. A good time might be Sunday between 2 and 5. Venture Crew: Venture Crew 11 to be chartered by Mountain View Methodist Church. They will not meet on Monday nights. We will ask that the Boy Scout troop will be their primary registration and that Venture will be secondary. This program is to provide an *additional* opportunity, not to replace Boy Scouts. Venturing is a co-educational program that includes young people from age 14-20. Beyond First

Class rank, advancement in Venturing will count toward Boy Scout advancement. It was suggested that there might be tied from the youth program at Mountain View's youth program to get these to participate.

There will be a **backpacking meeting** at 3:00 PM at the Einertson's home. This is a very important and informative meeting. Anyone interested in backpacking should be there.

Fall Family Camping: 14 are signed up already. Many advancements have been made since the last court of honor, so turnout should be high.

Backpacking checkout hike: 7 are currently signed up.
