- 1. Cumberland Island: 14 have signed up, 4 adults and 10 scouts. May need to use the trailer or get a 5th vehicle. Big expense with pulling trailer. Reservations for 14 to ride ferry.
- 2. BP trip to Pine MT: fun trip this past weekend.
- 3. NYLT: 4 scouts have signed up. Scott, Tim, Sam, and ? Logan may be the 5th. A couple of scouts are still trying to decide.
- 4. National Honor Roll: (Patrol): Requirements to fill. Good building experience for patrols.
- 5. Bethlehem Walk: everything went well. Recommended to notify police that scouts are suppose to be there.
- 6. Flour War: Great time, long day. Panty hose worked well. Few minor injuries. Well set up. Need to restrict boundaries.
- 7. Winter Campout at Bert Adams: Wilderness Survival Course was offered. It got down to single digits with the temperature. It was colder than SWC. Board games were played and adults were pulled in to play. Mrs. Ritchie was there. They will go back next year.
