

- Must be have completed an approved Youth Leader Training within last 2.5 years
- Must be active and in good standing with the troop

Job Description

- Attends meetings regularly
 - Arrives at the meetings no later than 6:40 PM to allow troop members to check out and return equipment
 - Remains after the meetings for a minimum of 20 minutes to allow troop members to check out and return equipment
- Keeps records on patrol and troop equipment.
- Inventories equipment in the shed

- Makes sure equipment is in good working condition.
- Issues equipment and makes sure it is returned in good condition.
 - May make recommendations for younger scouts regarding the type of equipment needed for events
 - Make certain that troop rules regarding the check out of equipment are followed
