Recruitment Coordinator/Troop Guide Coach Job Description

Recruitment Coordinator

- 1. Develop and maintain up-to-date list of Webelo 1 and 2 leaders at local Cub Scout Packs (i.e., Davis, Mountain View, Rocky Mount, Garrison Mill, Kehely, others).
- 2. Extend invitations, as appropriate, to attend Fall Camporall as guests of Troop 714. Fall Camporall it typically held in late September. Invitations need to be extended late July, early August.
- 3. Serve as "host" during the Fall Camporall. Enlist the help of the Troop Guides.
- 4. Send emails to Webelo 2 contacts periodically throughout the Fall to update them on Troop 714 activities and extend invitations to visit.
- 5. Host Webelo 2 visits at Troop meetings. Enlist the help of Troop Guides.
- 6. Shortly after January 1, start extending invitations to Webelo 2 dens to cross over to Troop 714.
- 7. Attend cross over events (typically in February and March) to welcome New Scouts and Leaders to Troop 714. Enlist the help of Troop Guides.
- 8. Coordinate and staff New Scout Campout (typically around the 3rd week in April). Enlist the help of the Troop Guides.
- 9. Host other boys and parents who may visit from time to time throughout the year.

Troop Guide Coach

- 1. Develop a description of the Troop Guide position.
- 2. Review and approve Troop Guides as selected by the SPL.
- 3. Provide Troop Guide training to ensure the Troop Guides understand the responsibilities of the position and have the requisite skills.
- 4. Assist the Recruitment Coordinator with Camporall and Webelo Troop meeting visits. Make sure Troop Guides are prepared to be involved with these events.
- 5. Coordinate with New Scout leaders to ensure that Troop Guides are interfacing with and providing leadership service to New Scout patrol(s) on a routine basis (i.e., "What do the New Scouts need from the Troop Guides? When do you need it?").
- 6. Ensure Troop Guides are prepared to host visitors during Troop meetings and other special events (e.g., Camporall, etc.).
- 7. Attend the New Scout Campout.
- 8. Ensure Troop Guides are prepared to play a significant leadership role on the New Scout Campout.
- 9. Review and sign off on leadership requirements associated with rank advancement for the Troop Guides.
