

National Youth Leadership Training Course (NYLT)

REQUIREMENTS: Age 13 and completed 7th grade by course date; First Class rank; Attended Boy Scout Summer Camp twice

NYLT (National Youth Leadership Training) is the premier leadership training opportunity for Boy Scouts. It is a weeklong camping experience at Bert Adams Scout Reservation and teaches leadership,

communication, and personal development skills through activities, events, games, and adventures. Participants will work hard and play hard together as they put into action the best Scouting has to offer. Most of the senior youth leadership in Troop 714 has attended NYLT and it pays great dividends for those Scouts and for the T-714program.

There are a limited number of slots available for the entire Atlanta Area Council, so you must apply early if you plan to attend.

There are three steps to apply:

- 1) Readall the information on the NYLT web page: http://www.aacnylt.org. Check the dates of the courses to see which one(s) work best for you and your family:

- 2) Contact Mr. Moultrie to discuss your plans with him. You must meet all the listed requirements and be willing and expecting to be a youth leader in Troop 714!
- 3) With your parent, complete online application and payment (Use the "Signup!!"button at the top/center on site http://www.aacnylt.org.)

A limited number of council funded need-based full scholarships are available - see the application. Also, see note below about T-714 funded partial scholarships below.

Additional NYLT Scholarship Opportunities from Troop-714

Because of the value of NYLT training to Troop 714, we offer a partial scholarship for those who successfully complete the NYLT course. Currently, this scholarship is \$90 of the \$225 total cost of the NYLT course. To receive the scholarship, you mustcomplete all four of the requirements below (no checks issued until all four are complete):

- 1) Successfully complete the course (the course director will notify Mr. Moultrie).
- 2) Commit to seek and actively serve at least two future terms in a troop leadership position (Patrol Leader, Troop Officer, SPL or ASPL) (Den Chief does not count).
- 3) Meet with Mr. Moultrie within 60 days following the completion of your course to discuss what you learned at NYLT and how it will benefit you and the troop. You will also develop and agree on at least four goals for how you can utilize the skills you have learned in NYLT in your day-to-day life and leadership in T-714.
- 4) Commit to participate as staff in the next Troop ILST (Introduction to Leadership Skills) course offering. Generally this will be offered in late summer and early winter as preparation for the elections coming up in November and May. (Scholarship check will be issued based on your commitment to ILST participation; it isn't held until after the ILST course, which may be a few months out. A Scout is Trustworthy!)

That's it -- with just that little bit of effort, you can attend NYLT for as little as \$135!! This is a bargain the parents should easily appreciate - a teen aged Scout can easily eat \$135 worth of food in a week at home!
