

## Troop 714 Adult Vision/Goals 2018-2019

Vision: Troop 714 builds a culture that supports youth character development, leadership, and advancement opportunities.

### Goals:

- 1- Ensure the position of Scoutmaster has a smooth and positive transition successfully completed by February 24, 2019.
- 2- Support the scouts in planning and advancement opportunities so that the troop achieves JTE Gold and District Honor Roll (Chicken Pin).
  - a. Hold a troopwide MB Clinic open to other troops providing at least 4 Eagle required MB classes as well as elective MB classes.
  - b. Run 1<sup>st</sup> Aid MB clinic for new scouts and any other scouts who need to complete (May 11, 2019).
  - c. Support patrols in meeting their service project commitments including projects for MVUMC, Scouting for Food, Summer Lunch, and our community.
- 3- Be positive role models for the scouts:
  - a. Leaders should be fully uniformed - Model the habit of wearing the uniform correctly for all meetings and activities.
  - b. Respect the Scout Sign for silence; make sure side conversations take place outside the meeting room.
- 4- Be available to scouts for discussion and interaction:
  - a. Make time for the scouts when they need attention – to answer questions, give guidance etc.
  - b. Work with mb counselor coordinator (Gary) to recruit and train merit badge counselors to increase coverage as needed.
    - i. Continue to offer mb cleanup opportunities before at least 1 troop meeting every other month.
- 5- Ensure the health and future of the troop through recruitment of new scouts.
  - a. Work with Dr R and Mrs D to ensure Webelo recruitment.
  - b. Recruit an adult to work towards building closer relationships with local packs.
  - c. Look for opportunities to help the scouts be visible to potential recruits in middle schools.
- 6- Trained Adults: All scouting events (including patrol activities and Eagle scout workdays) require at least 2 registered, trained adults as of October 1, 2018.
  - a. 70% ASMS and 90% Committee members shall be fully trained by May 31, 2019.
